

PORTE SAINT-MARTIN | SAINT-ÉMILION



Grassed area with a watering hole. Benches (no tables), bins.



From the Tourism Office, take the rue des Anciennes Écoles. At the very end of the street, turn right through the old Porte Saint-Martin. The small garden is immediately on your left below.



You will also find, two stone benches and tables on Rue du Couvent, with a view from the back of la Tour du Roy.

There are also stone benches at Porte Brunet in Saint-Emilion.



PARC GUADET | SAINT-ÉMILION

500 M



Grassed municipal park, benches (no tables), litter bin, playground. Butcher's shop and « Utile » corner shop nearby. Car park and toilets nearby.



Parc Guadet is located in the north of the village, close to the Saint-Emilion roundabout. To get there by car, take the roundabout and follow the signs for Montagne (D122). The entrance to the car park is a few meters ahead on your left (follow the Gendarmerie sign).



THE BARBANNE AREA | MONTAGNE

3 KM



Grassed area with car park. Six picnic tables, litter bins.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne (to the north). The Barbanne area is by the roadside, on your right, at 2km from the entrance of the Yelloh camping.



Tables in a tree-filled and grassy park.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for "Saint-Emilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards "La Gaffelière". At the entrance of Saint-Emilion, turn left towards Saint-Laurent-des-Combes on the D245. In the city center, turn right towards the town hall. After the railway, turn right again and the park is on your left after about 500m.

ROMAN CHURCH | SAINT-SULPICE-DE-FALEYRENS

4,5 KM



Two tables are located behind the church. Bakery nearby.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for "Saint-Emilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Go through the village, cross the railway line, turn left immediately, then take the roundabout. Take the first exit to continue along the D19E1 towards Saint-Sulpice-de-Faleyrens. In Saint-Sulpice-de-Faleyrens centre village, turn left at the stop sign and park by the church. Continue on foot, turning right after the church and turn right again at the next intersection. Your destination is at the end of the road.

THE CALONS MILLS | MONTAGNE

6 KM



Four tables, a litter bin and a shaded area in undergrowth. Remarkable panoramic view. Possibility of visiting the Mills on appointment (M. Boidron - 06 11 91 07 60). Botanic walk.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, take the D122 exit towards Montagne, heading north. At the entrance of Montagne, turn left at the stop sign to the D244. Take the second road on your right "Route de Bertin" then go straight for 500m.

The Calons Mills will be on your left.





Grassed area, two tables with benches and a litter bin.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, take the D243 exit towards Saint-Christophe des Bardes and continue straight for 2,2km. After Château Badette, leave the D243, turn left, and drive alongside Châteaux Moulin de Lagnet (to the left) and Laplagnotte-Bellevue (to the right). After the small stone bridge over the Barbanne, turn right on the "Chemin de Tuilerie de Cazelon" and continue for 3,8km ("Chemin Tuilerie" then "Arvouet"). At the crossroads ("Chemin Arvouet" and "Montagne"), the area will be opposite, on the right.

LA CROIX DE TOURANS | SAINT-ETIENNE-DE-LISSE

7 KM



Tree-filled and shaded area with an awesome point of view on the plains.





At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for "Saint-Emilion sud". Turn left at the end of the diversion to leave the village. As you enter La Gaffelière, turn right immediately towards St-Laurent-des-Combes – St-Etienne-de-Lisse (D245).

After a few kilometres, drive through St-Etienne-de-Lisse, pass in front of the town hall, and then, as you leave the village, turn left immediately (D130) to park in the school parking. Take the path alongside the house and the vineyard (close to the "give way" sign), which will take you to the top of the plateau.

The picnic area is located in the woods, a five-minute walk from the car park.



PICNIC AREA AT THE OLD PRESBYTERY | NÉAC

7,5 KM



Two tables and benches, litter bin.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for Libourne (D243) for around 2 to 3 km, then turn right when you see the sign for Pomerol – Néac (D245). Follow the signs for Néac. At the centre village entrance, follow the road up the hill, then turn immediately left when you reach the top, towards the church. The car park is on your right, a few meters after the church. The picnic area is next to the cemetery and offers a point of view of the Barbanne.



Shaded grassy area along the Dordogne, featuring two tables and two benches and a car park. There are also landscape interpretation panels.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for "Saint-Emilion Sud". Turn left at the end of the road to follow La Gallelière. Go through the village, then cross the railway line. At the stop signs, turn left onto the roundabout. Take the first exit to continue on the D670 towards Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac. Turn right onto D243E2. Turn slightly left, then facing the river, turn right.





AREA OF FONTMURÉE | MONTAGNE

8 KM



Grassed area with car park, two tables and benches, a litter bin.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance of the village, continue straight at the stop sign. Follow "Route d'Ambrois" and "Route de Paradis/C205" towards "Route des Artigues/D122E5". Turn left onto "Route des Artigues/D122E5". After Château Calon, turn right onto "Route de Fontmurée". At the crossroads with the D121E2, go straight on then take the first right towards "Chemin du Lavoir". The area is located by the washing place.

AREA OF SAINT-GENÈS | SAINT-GENÈS-DE-CASTILLON





A table near the tennis court and the church.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the D243E1 et D243 towards Saint-Genès-de-Castillon for 8,2 km. At the Saint-Genès-de-Castillon entrance, you will see the village church on your left. Turn left immediately afterwards. The picnic area is 150 m on the right.



Four tables and benches, litter bins, toilets, children's play area, healthcare circuit. Close to the centre of Lussac.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout, follow the signs for Montagne to enter the village. Upon reaching Montagne, turn right at the stop sign to drive through the village. Shortly after the church, turn left, following signs for Lussac. Once in Lussac, continue straight through the village along "Rue de Verdun" and "Rue de Gambetta", until arriving at "Place de la République, where the church is located. Proceed down the "Rue du 8 mai 1945", which runs alongside the right side of the church. At the end of the street, turn right around the cemetery. The area is a little further to the left.

PUISSEGUIN MEMORIAL | PUISSEGUIN

10 KM



Grassed area. Two tables and benches, litter bins, and toilets.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout follow the signs for Montagne as far as the village. At the entrance to Montagne, turn right at the stop sign to go through the village. After the church, continue straight ahead on the D244 for 4km. At the crossroads with the D17, "Longues Règes", turn right onto the D17, towards "Puisseguin-bourg". Arriving at Lussac, continue straight on through the village, past the town hall and on to St Pierre church where you can park. The memorial is below the church, on the right.

LAMPROIE GARDEN | LAVAGNAC (SAINTE-TERRE)

10KM



Six tables and benches, litter bins, and toilets in the municipal hall.

The area is located in the centre of Lavagnac at the Jardin de la Lamproie, with local shops just a few metres away.



At the Saint-Emilion roundabout follow the signs for "Saint-Emilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Go through the village, then over the railway line. At the stop sign, turn left onto the roundabout. Take the first exit and continue along the D670 towards Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac. Enter in Lavagnac, and the Jardin de la Lamproie is in the centre of town, on your left.



Petanque court available.







Grassed area, four tables and benches, litter bins and watering place. The car park and toilets are nearby, located next to the Monbadon Church with a view of the Château de Monbadon.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance to the village, turn right at the stop sign. Go straight through the village on the D244 towards Puisseguin for 5km. At the crossroads with the D17, turn left onto the D17 and after 500m turn slightly right onto the D244 for 1km. At the intersection, turn right onto the D21 towards Villefranche-de-Lonchat. The hamlet of Monbadon will be on your left after 1.5km.

PICNIC AREA | SAINT-CIBARD

15 KM



Grassed area, two table-benches, litter bin. Car park nearby.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance to the village, turn right at the stop sign. Continue through the village on the D244 towards Puisseguin for 5km. At the crossroads with the D17, turn left onto the D17, and after 500m turn slightly right onto the D244 for 1km. At the junction, turn right onto the D21 towards Villefranche-de-Lonchat, and 4km further on, turn left onto the D21 towards Saint-Cibard. The car park is located next to the town hall.

PICNIC AREA | PETIT-PALAIS-ET-CORNEMPS

16,3KM



Leisure area with fitness trail. Five tables, a litter bin and watering hole nearby (no toilets).

At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance to the village, turn right at the stop sign. Continue straight through the village on the D244 towards Puisseguin for 4.7 km.



At the crossroads, turn left onto the D17 towards Monbadon - St-Cibard - Francs and follow this road for 1.9km. Always follow the D17 - signs for Monbadon/St-Cibard/Francs/St-Médard-de-Guizières).

Turn slightly right onto the D21 and follow this road for 4.7km. The leisure area will be on your left.



PICNIC AREA | FRANCS



Grassed area, three shaded stone tablebenches. Car park nearby.

At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance to the village, turn right at the stop sign. Continue straight through the village on the D244 towards Puisseguin for 5km. At the crossroads with the D17, turn left onto the D17 towards Monbadon - St-Cibard - Francs. After 600m, turn slightly right onto the D244 and then right onto the D21. Follow the road for 5.5km, then, turn left onto the D119.

There is a car park 400m along on your left. The picnic area is at the end of the car park on the left.



BONUS - OUTSIDE SAINT-EMILION AREA

PICNIC AREA | CABARA



Grassed area on the banks of the Dordogne (partly shaded), three tables and litter bins.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the signs for "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Go through the village, then over the railway line.

At the stop sign, turn left onto the roundabout. Take the first exit and continue along the D670 towards Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac.

Cross the bridge into Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac, then turn right towards Branne on the bend D18, and 1 km further on, turn right again towards "Cabara" on the Avenue du Port D18. The picnic area will be on your right, 800 m further on.
